| | 2. Complete the <i>Counselor Information Form</i> Answer the questions in great detail - pretend these are questions on your college applications! | | 3. Complete the Teacher Information Forms This should be completed for both teachers you are asking to write a letter of recommendation. | | 4. | | 5. If you are Planning to Play a Sport in College, Register with the NCAA Eligibility Center Go to <u>NCAA Eligibility Center</u> and click on Register. Follow instructions to register for NCAA. | Spring Junior Year | NC49 Eligibility Center |
| | 6. Submit <u>Waiver of Rights and Records Release</u> <u>Form</u> This form must be submitted to the registrar prior to any transcript or letter of recommendation being sent. | Spring Junior Year | <u>Waiver of Rights</u> <u>and Records</u> <u>Release Form</u> |

| | 7. If Using Common Application: Create a <u>Common App account</u> Add all colleges you wish to apply to under "My Colleges" in your Common App Complete the "Education" section and Sign FERPA Then, <u>MATCH</u> your common app/Naviance accounts You should MATCH after August 15. | 20 School Days prior to first college deadline BUT not before August 15 | APPLY NOW THE COMMON APPLICATION For Undergraduate College Admitsion |
| | 8. Add colleges to "Colleges I'm applying to" in Naviance. A step-by-step student guide and slideshow for instructions are linked. | | 9. Invite teacher recommenders in Naviance (teachers cannot submit without this invitation) Select the teacher you would like to write a letter for each college from the drop down menu. Repeat for additional teachers. NOTE: You will not invite teachers to complete a recommendation through Common App and Coalition. You will <u>only</u> invite through Naviance. Note: You MUST have already asked the teacher to write your letter AND they have confirmed AND you completed the teacher information form in Naviance. | | 10. Request Test Scores Be Sent To Colleges Test scores MUST be sent directly by the student from ACT or The College Board. Log on to your ACT and/or <u>Collegeboard</u> account and follow the instructions to have your scores sent to your list of colleges. To learn which schools are test optional, visit <u>fairtest.org</u> . Also, many schools allow you to self-report and save money! | | 11. Complete the Free Application for Student Aid Complete the form as early as possible after it becomes available Maryland FAFSA deadline to be considered for state aid is March 1st. It's FREE to complete the FAFSA! | Available Oct 1 | FAFSA Application |



| | 12. Complete the College Scholarship Profile (CSS) Refer to the <u>list</u> of participating colleges/universities. IF applicable, should be submitted 2 weeks prior to the earliest college application deadline. | Available Dec 1 | <u>CSS Profile</u> |
